- An Entry fee of \$175 per entry will apply to All Award entries
- Entry fees are not required until you have completed your entry.

- For Business Awards, the independent panel of 15+ judges is made up of business coaches, trade and consumer media, key independent figures within the industry and non-industry business experts.
- For Photographic Awards, the independent panel of 15+ judges is made up of key national and international iconic barbers, hairdressers and media.
- For AMBA Product Awards, the independent panel of 8+ judges per category is made up of Australian media from varying magazines, blogs, social platforms and online media vehicles.
- Judging decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Please make sure all your personal details are entered accurately, including contact details, as this will be used in the awards presentation if selected as a finalist.
- For AMBA you are eligible to enter more than one category, as long as the work submitted meets the criteria and an entry fee is paid.
- AMBA is an Australian Competition and entrants must have resided in Australia for the full judging period.
- Entry fees may be paid by credit card or PayPal only and must be paid online at time of completing submissions. If your submissions have not been paid for at close of entry they may not be included for judging.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR ENTRY AND JUDGING PROCESS

1. Read each content block requirement carefully
2. The judges will look at all entries in full and give an overall rating score taking into consideration criteria content and attachments.
3. Rating scores will be added by an independent auditor and from that the highest rated entrants will be named as finalists in each category.
4. The winner of each category is determined based on the highest score and in the event of a draw a secondary round of judging of finalists will be carried out.

1. For multiple images required upload one single multi-paged pdf file. Maximum file size is 5MB per piece.

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IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING PHOTOGRAPHIC CATEGORIES

ALL COLLECTIONS MUST HAVE BEEN CREATED WITHIN THE AWARDS PERIOD OF 1ST JUNE 2019 – 31ST MAY 2020

Collections must not have been published in any format, or seen on any media platform, either print, online or social, must be unique to the AMBA's and not have been entered into any other hair competition.

Collections need to have been photographed professionally and form a cohesive photographic collection with plain studio or on-location back drop. They MUST NOT be just salon shots of hairstyles created in an everyday situation.

Wigs, wefts, hairpieces and hair extensions are NOT permitted.

You must supply a collection of 4 photos showing 4 different looks on 4 different models.

Collection can be in Black and White or colour.

All photos must be uploaded as a multi-page PDF less than 5mg in size, however if you reach finalist status you will be required to upload to drop box high res images and could also be required to supply block mounted versions of imagery for display at the awards event. These will need to be provided as A4 (210 x 297mm) and mounted on cardboard or foam (no thicker than 5mm), without any border showing

Collections may be published as soon as the finalist announcements have been made and NOT before.

AMBA PHOTOGRAPHIC & BUSINESS CATEGORIES

AUSTRALIAN MODERN BARBER OF THE YEAR

This award is given to a Barber who can best demonstrate excellence in ALL barbering skills, mens cutting and styling, customer care, training, retail sales and an overall contribution to the Barbershop or salon. This award is restricted to a barber, who must be fully qualified and be employed full time in a barbershop or salon. This award is open to an employee, independent contractor or shop owner.

WRITTEN SECTION

INFORMATION REQUIRED ON THE ENTRY SITE IS:-

Opening Statement: Explain your general day to day duties within the shop/salon and why you believe yourself to be the best modern barber of the year.

Biography: Give us a brief history of your career to date. Include age.

Contribution to the Shop/Salon: What do you do to contribute to the shop/salon?

For example:-

- details of day to day activities
- details of any internal training provided
- charitable or social activities organised
- other (as relevant)

Training and Inspiration: How do you keep up-to-date with the latest techniques and trends?

Please provide:

- other (as relevant)

Customer care: Describe the ideal client's journey you activate yourself or instil in your staff, from consultation through to aftercare and re-booking.

Can also provide information such as:

- average number of clients per week
- average bill
- rebooking statistics
- upsells to include treatments and technical services
- retail results (including average client spend)

How you guide your staff with Key Performance indicators in terms of the above

Qualifications: Give details of the qualifications you hold that assist with your position and additional study you have undertaken to enhance the quality of your role.

Special Activities (Optional): Have you been involved in any shows, extra-curricular activity or promotions and if so, what role did you play in them?

Skill Set, Goals and Expertise: Explain what you believe to be your best skill set, what your future goals are and where you see your area of expertise. Include what you do to be the best Barber you can be.

AUSTRALIAN MODERN BARBER BUSINESS OF THE YEAR

Entrants must be a stand-alone Barbershop or Mens only Hair Salon. This award is given to barbershop or mens salon that shows the highest excellence in facilities, environment, customer care, services, creative ability, menu and training.

Opening Statement: State why your Barbershop or Mens only salon should be awarded as the Best Barber Business of the Year and how you have demonstrated excellence.

Full Description of Your Barbershop: Give a full description of your barbershop/mens only salon including any relevant history, size, position, number of staff, demographic of clientele, services and any other information that supports your entry.

Success of Barbershop: Explain the success your salon has enjoyed during the period June 1st 2019 – May 31st 2020

Customer Experience: Explain what you offer your customers to make their experience the best that it can be before, during and after their visit.

Staff and Training: What training do you offer your staff both on and off site, what incentives do you offer and what additional activities do you have in place help them be the best that they can be.

BEST MENS COLLECTION - CLASSIC

This award is given to a qualified Barber who can produce a classic collection that is commercial and uses skilled barbering techniques that can include, cutting, clipping, fading, styling, grooming and dressing to show current or fashion forward styles and trends. This award is open to an employee, independent contractor or shop owner.

WRITTEN SECTION

The written section is not judged on. This is for the organisers to have information on the entrant should they become a finalist and/or winner.

Be imaginative in this category. This award is open to an employee, independent contractor or shop owner.

This award is open to employees, independent contractors, educators or shop owners and can comprise of both qualified and apprentice barbers

BEST BUSINESS DIRECTOR/OWNER OF THE YEAR

This award is given to the Best Barbershop Director/Owner who can demonstrate excellence in motivation of individuals and the team, interpersonal skills, business acumen, marketing, innovation and management style. This award is restricted to an individual(s) who owns a Barbershop(s) or Men's hair salon.

INFORMATION REQUIRED ON THE ENTRY SITE IS:-

Opening Statement: Give details of your day to day role within the shop and what makes you the business director/owner of the year. Include the goals and ambitions you have for the future both for you personally and for your business. (Restricted to 500 words)

Career History: Give details of your career to date, including your employment history.

Keeping Up To Date: Explain how you keep up-to-date to ensure that you and your staff are at the forefront of your profession when it comes to skills. Include what plans you have for future training

Success of Salon: Explain the success your business has enjoyed during the period June 1st 2019 – May 31st 2020

Promotion of the Barber Industry: Give details of how you have promoted the barber industry continually in a positive light through every channel available to you, within the salon environment, the local area and in the hair industry at large.

Photograph: Please supply a photograph of yourself

Photo of Salon: Provide a photo of your salon work environment.

Supporting documents & images: Include any additional photos or documentation that you feel is required to support your entry

BEST MEN'S EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR – Individual or Organisation

This award is given to an individual or organisation that has shown excellence in mens hair education and whose training and commitment to the industry has been demonstrated through the growth and skill level of others during the period of June 1st 2019 – May 31st 2020. This category is open to independent/individual educators representing themselves and not employed by a product company or an educational organisation specifically in relation to men's education. If individual, the educator may act as an ambassador for a product company, but this work must not be their sole source of income. They will need to demonstrate that the education offered is solely under their own name or their own business name.

INFORMATION REQUIRED ON THE ENTRY SITE IS:-

Opening Statement: Explain what makes you unique in the field of education. Why you are passionate about educating in the barbering industry. What you feel your strengths are, how you measure your success and why you should hold the title of best men's educator of the year. (Restricted to 500 words)

History: Include CV style information on your Career History to date or overview of history or organisation.

Contribution to the Industry: Give details of how you have contributed to the barber industry continually in a positive light through every channel available to you, within your work environment, through the media, with your students and in the hair industry at large.

Programs and Seminars (optional): Give details of the training programs/seminars that you offer or have been involved in during the period of June 1st 2019 – May 31st 2020. You may give info here and/or upload in the attachments section.

Training Audience: Give details of who you have trained and companies/salons/shops/individuals you may have worked with in terms of your educating.

Evaluation and Resources: What evaluation systems do you have in place for your students/attendees and what resources do you offer over and above personal training and education.

BEST CUSTOMER CARE

This award is given to the Barbershop who can demonstrate excellence in the area of customer care and goes beyond the norm to treat their guests in the best way possible.

Opening Statement: Explain what practices and procedures you implement in your Barbershop to give your clients the best customer care and make you an award winner. (Restricted to 500 words)

Customer Experience: Explain what you offer your customers to make their experience the best that it can be before, during and after their visit.

Unique experience: Give a full description of what makes you unique in your customer care service and what sets you apart.

Full Description of Your Shop: Give a full description of your Barbershop including any relevant history, size, position, number of staff, demographic of clientele, services and any other information that supports your entry

BEST BARBERSHOP DESIGN AWARD

This award is given to the Barbershop that has undergone a complete renovation or has opened as a new salon during the period June 1st 2017 – May 31st 2020 i.e. within the last 3 years.

INFORMATION REQUIRED ON THE ENTRY SITE IS:-

Opening Statement: Explain the main features of your shop design, why they were chosen and what influence the design has had on your salon success. (Restricted to 500 words)

Branding and Identity: Give a brief synopsis of your creative identity and branding and how this translates to your shop through your website, signage, stationery and imagery.

Financials: Give some details of the budget and final spend for the design and shop fit-out.

Aesthetics: Explain the inspiration behind your design, how and why you chose the furniture, essentials and decorating items required to achieve the look you were after.

AMBA HAIR CARE, HAIR STYLE AND BEARD PRODUCT AWARDS

Product companies are invited to put their products to the test in this exclusive, unique 'Clean-Skin' Competition where judges will rank their preference based purely on the product alone without any knowledge of the name or brand. Mocha Publishing will contract a re-packer to re-package entry into clean skin bottles, containers and jars, and simply number the packages.

Only Open to PROFESSIONAL SALON-ONLY PRODUCTS

Judges will be asked to use and test all products over a 6 week period and then rank them in order of preference without knowledge of the product name, manufacturer or distributor and based on aroma, use, preference, value for money and performance.

AMBA HAIR CARE PRODUCT OF THE YEAR - A SHAMPOO & CONDITIONER PAIR OR 2 IN 1 PRODUCT

Entries can only be accepted if they are in the form of a liquid.

AMBA HAIR STYLE PRODUCT OF THE YEAR - A STYLING WAX, CREAM or PASTE.

Entries can only be accepted if they are in the form of a wax, cream or paste.
